In 2006 we moved into purpose built premises and reaffirmed our commitment to environmental protection through innovations such as alcohol free printing, energy efficient lighting, low energy motors on compressors and presses, ensuring the most efficient use of energy supplied through the power factor correction and increased levels of recycling.

Our fundamental, ongoing environmental policy commitments are as follows:

- **We have a firm commitment to year-on-year continual improvement in our environmental performance;**
- **We are committed to the prevention of pollution in all of our activities;**
- **We are committed to full compliance with all applicable legal requirements and other requirements which may be relevant to the various aspects of our business**

We have identified the environmental issues associated with all of our activities, products and services. We aim to implement all reasonably practicable measures to manage, control and improve the related environmental impacts.

In achieving these aims the company will:

- **Develop, implement and achieve certification to the international standard for environmental management systems - ISO14001:2004 and FSC Accreditation**
- **Strive to ensure that all of our office and factory wastes are handled, stored and disposed of as required not only by legislation, but as examples of best practice;**
- **Work to reduce the amount of waste produced;**
- **Investigate all reasonable options for increasing recycling initiatives;**
- **Investigate measures which would reduce the consumption of raw materials;**
- **Improve biodiversity in landscaped areas;**
- **Develop, and periodically review objectives and targets to support this policy with the aim of improving our environmental performance;**
- **Exercise control, as far as is possible, over the environmental impacts arising as a result of work being undertaken on our behalf by our sub-contractors, suppliers and maintenance contractors;**
- **Review this policy annually or in light of any new knowledge, changing legislation or public concerns; and**
- **Provide appropriate training to our employees to enable them to implement this environmental policy**

Our Directors have direct responsibility for the implementation of this environmental policy and an Environmental Representative has been appointed to ensure that our environmental management system is suitably established, implemented and maintained.
